### Dear Brother Knights,

On the first weekend of October, we had our Rose Sale at St. Joseph and Good Shepherd. Over \$1800 was raised to support Right to Life charities. Great job by those who volunteered to man the tables at each mass and to those parishioners who supported our efforts!

At our October meeting the brothers voted to dedicate money out of our reserve for the purpose of obtaining an ultrasound for a pregnancy resource center within the diocese. We are working with the diocese to identify where the unit could be placed. Due to the widespread use of the abortion pill, which is taken early in the pregnancy, centers are seeking the units that can show life as early as 5 weeks. I'm told by directors up to 50% of women who enter their centers either wanting or considering an abortion can be convinced to go full term. The overwhelming reason given is the ultrasound. Once the mother sees the image of an actual baby there is a chance it can be saved.

Our Life Chairman Jerry Woodring continues our prayer vigil at Newton's Planned Parenthood location. PP is open three days a week, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays. We give thanks to a group from OLQP who regularly take the first hour on Saturday, and for the Columbiettes who have also become regulars. We could sure use more Knights showing up to fill in empty one-hour slots. Contact Jerry to see where you can fill in an hour to protect the unborn. Sad note: After having lunch in Chester, Barbara and I noticed someone took the pro-life baby's feet magnet off our car. So sad that so many have been brainwashed to believe a baby isn't a baby, but just some blob of flesh that can be destroyed. We need to pray for those people, that they come to realize a life is taken with every abortion. By the time you read this election day will have more than likely passed. Did you vote pro-life? Remember James letter to the 12 tribes where he says, "...faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead." Let's continue to pray and show through our actions we are pro-life!
