### **HOW TO REGISTER FOR ZOOM**

Step 1: Go to <a href="www.zoom.us">www.zoom.us</a> and click on the "SIGN UP, IT'S FREE" button that's at the top-right corner of the screen.

Step 2: Verify your birth date. This will not be saved.

Step 3: Enter your e-mail address.

Step 4: An e-mail will be sent to the address you registered. Click on the confirmation link in that e-mail to begin using Zoom.
